

3rd Annual Adidas/Buckeye Prep Report Invitational

April 4-6, 2008

Game Rules

1. 2/14 minutes halves with stop & go clock. Two 3-minute overtime periods before sudden death.
2. Four timeouts total (2 full & 2 30 seconds per game). One extra timeout in overtime.
3. Three minute half-time warm-up.
4. Game time is forfeit time. No grace period will be allowed. (Director's Discretion)
5. Five minute pre-game warm-up.
6. Only one coach at a time can be standing during the game.
7. Fouls: Team fouls 7-9 results in a 1-and-1 situation (per half). Team fouls 10 or more results in a two shot penalty (per half).
8. Scores tied after regulation will result in three-minute overtime periods until the tie is broken.
9. AAU rules will be in effect. (Except for grade exceptions. No maximum)
10. If a player, coach or parent is ejected from a game for any reason, they are ejected for the rest of the tournament.
11. The top 2 teams in each bracket will advance to a single elimination tournament. (Could be more for uneven pools)
12. Tiebreaker criteria:
 - A. Won-lost record
 - B. Head-to-head competition;
 - C. Point system (+15 / -15). (Note -- Regardless of the point difference, "winning margin," no team will receive more than a plus "15" or a minus "15" for point differential. For example, if team "A" wins by 20 points, team "A" will receive a +15 for that game.) Also, only the teams involved in the tie will be subject to the point system formula;
 - D. Least amount of points allowed in pool games;
 - E. Coin flip.
13. The home team may have to keep the official book and will provide a scorekeeper. The visiting team may have to provide a clock operator.
14. The home team is the 1st team listed on the schedule and will wear light colored jerseys and the visiting team will wear dark colored jerseys.
15. We will be using a regulation-sized basketball (big ball) for 2010 2011 2012
16. Coaches must have birth certificates in hand in case of challenges. If a player is found to be ineligible, the player will be ejected from the tournament and the team will forfeit all games in which the player participated.

Note: An All-Tournament Team and MVP will be selected (by director) at the conclusion of the championship game. In addition, individual awards will be presented to the champion and runner-up teams.
